



## 2014-15 Academic Year Opportunities

### Queer Discussion Group Facilitator

- Overview: The Office of LGBT Life provides 4-5 weekly Queer Discussion Group during the academic year. The groups are identity based and provide opportunities for students to connect with other members of the community; explore their identities; and increase their knowledge of gender, sexuality, faith, race, class, and more. The groups are for and led by undergraduate and graduate students.
- Time Commitment: 3 hours/week in addition to 12 hours of training in August.

- Other: Unpaid. Must commit to the entire academic year.

### Q-Leaders

- Overview: The Office of LGBT Life is launching an educational curriculum to increase awareness and knowledge related to gender and sexuality. Q-Leaders will facilitate programs and educational sessions in classrooms and residence halls as well as for student organizations.
- Time Commitment: 2 hours/week in addition to training time.

- Other: Unpaid. Must commit to the entire academic year.

### Safe Space Facilitators

- Overview: The Emory Safe Space Program provides a curriculum to students, faculty and staff that raises awareness of issues related to gender and sexuality; establishes a common knowledge of identity development and support resources; and supports engaged members of the Emory community in their daily work to create equity on and off campus. Volunteers facilitate the curriculum for Emory faculty, staff, and students. Click [here](#) for the full facilitator job description.
- Time Commitment: Facilitate one 3.5 hour training per month plus a one hour facilitator meeting per month. An additional 8 hour facilitator training session is required in late summer.

- Other: Unpaid. This is a two-year commitment. Staff and faculty applicants preferred.

### Office of LGBT Life Advisory Committee

- Overview: The purpose of this Committee is: (1) to provide advice and input to the Office's Director and staff on planning, implementation, and operational aspects of the Office; (2) to ensure that the programs and services of the Office are consistent with and inform the missions of Emory University and Emory University's Division of Campus Life; (3) to facilitate communication between the University community and the Office; and (4) to serve as advocates and ambassadors for the Office's goals and objectives in creating an equitable and inclusive campus environment. The Director of the Office may seek advice from the Advisory Committee on various matters.
- Time Commitment: 1.5 hours/month in addition to a fall orientation session.

- Other: Unpaid. This is a two-year commitment for faculty & staff and a minimum of a one-year commitment for students.

- Time Commitment: 10-12 hours/week.
